Mr. Paul Veldhoff asked that his property be rezoned from rural residential to agricultural. Chair Garofalo stated that changes happening at the state level make it difficult for townships to act with authority on agricultural matters at the present.

Mr. Veldhoff stated that his parcel was agricultural before the township rezoned it rural residential. It is more than a mile from an electric pole and would be impractical to build on. Trustee Smith stated this rezoning was done in 2004 to reduce spot zoning and make parcels more uniform in the township.

After further discussion, Carol Browne made a motion supported by Harry Smith to table this request until more definitive information can be obtained from the township attorney. An amendment to the motion was made to insure that Mr. Veldhoff would not have to pay an additional fee. <u>Motion passed</u>.
