TO VOTE: Completely darken the oval opposite your choice, as shown:

IMPORTANT: To mark your ballot, use only a black or blue ink pen. **DO NOT USE ANY OTHER INK COLOR!**

PARTISAN SECTION: There are two party sections on the ballot: Republican Party and Democratic Party. Select the party section of your choice. **YOU MAY VOTE IN ONE PARTY SECTION ONLY; YOU CANNOT "SPLIT YOUR TICKET." IF YOU VOTE IN MORE THAN ONE PARTY SECTION, YOUR PARTISAN BALLOT WILL BE REJECTED.**



DO NOT vote for more candidates than indicated under each office title.

WRITE-IN CANDIDATES: To vote for a candidate whose name is not printed on the ballot, write or place the name of that candidate in the blank space provided and completely darken the oval. Do not cast a write-in vote for a candidate whose name is already printed on the ballot for that office.

CHECK BOTH SIDES OF BALLOT: This ballot has two sides. Be certain to check the reverse side of the ballot.

WHEN YOU HAVE COMPLETED VOTING: Place the ballot in the secrecy sleeve so that votes cannot be seen and the numbered stub is visible. Return the ballot to the election official stationed at the tabulator. (If voting by absentee ballot, follow the instructions provided by the clerk for returning the ballot.)

NOTE: If you make a mistake, return your ballot to the election official and obtain a new ballot. Do not attempt to erase or correct any marks made in error.

STATE	STATE	<p>Shall the County of Allegan, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Thirty Two Million Dollars [\$32,000,000.00] and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds for the purpose of: constructing, remediating, renovating, furnishing, and equipping a new Sheriff's Office and Corrections Center, and providing for related site improvements and all necessary appurtenances and attachments upon the site of and in the former Haworth Seating Plant in the City of Allegan?</p> <p>The following is for informational purposes only:</p> <p>The maximum number of years the bonds may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, will not exceed Twenty [20] years. The estimated millage that may be levied for the proposed bonds in the year 2010 is .4470 mills [\$0.4470 per \$1000 of taxable valuation]. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is .6247 mills [\$0.6247 per \$1000 of taxable valuation] over the term of the debt. Shall the Allegan District Library, County of Allegan, Michigan, levy an amount not to exceed .85 mill (\$.85 on each \$1,000 dollars of taxable value) against all taxable real and tangible personal property within the Allegan District Library District for a period of ten (10) years, 2010 to 2019, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all District Library purposes authorized by law, and shall the District Library levy such new additional millage for said purpose; the estimate of the revenue the District Library will collect if the millage is approved and levied by the Library in the 2010 calendar year is approximately \$446,000? A portion of the revenue may be required to be distributed to the City of Allegan Downtown Development Authority.
